KICKING OFF THE IFSC WORLD CUP SEASON IN CHONGING, CHINA ON APRIL 26-27, 2014

All eyes are on Southwest China and the municipality of Chongqing for the first World Cup of 2014. The best international climbers in Lead and Speed will meet in the "city on rivers" for the first two contests of this fresh season.

After a winter focused on preparation, training, and recuperation, the IFSC World Cup climbers will be back in business as of April 26th! The season opens with two competitions, in Speed and Boulder that are sure to be full of outstanding performances.

Top-ranked women's boulderer from 2013 Anna Stöhr will be defending her spot against Akiyo Noguchi, Alex Puccio, and Shauna Coxsey, while in the men's field, of last seasons top-ranked podium, Dimitrii Sharafutdinof, Jakob Schubert, and Sean McColl, only Sharafutdinof is on the starters list, but Kilian Fischhuber, Jorg Verhoeven, and Jan Hojer, are sure to keep Sharafutdinof anything but comfortable on his top spot.

In Speed, Alina Gaidamakina, Iuliia Kaplina, and Aleksandra Rudzinska, who was last year's champion at Chongqing, will be defending their 2013 podium positions on the women's side. For men, Stanislav Kokorin, Libor Hroza, and Qixin Zhong, will set the bar high and ensure for some amazing competition!
